- c. Section I Note #2 decreased from hourly rate to flat \$50 rate.
- d. Section I Note #3 limited 2-hour labor minimum charge to weekday moves.
- e. Section II Fuel Surcharge increased 2%.
- f. Section III Packing Containers (Material Prices) Deleted sentence "Packing Containers/Material will be charged at Market Value price, plus 25%." Added a table listing the prices of packing containers and supplies.
- g. Page 7 Added new page entitled, "CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF UNIFORM HOUSEHOLD GOODS BILL OF LADING"; and changed claim filing from 9 months to 30 days.
- h. Make several non-substantive language changes and correct several typographical errors.

If the Application or Petition in this case contains a request for adjustment of rates, the rates are subject to potential modification by the Public Service Commission during the course of this case.
