PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION ANNOUNCES VIRTUAL PUBLIC NIGHT HEARING ON MARCH 19TH, 2020

The Public Service Commission ("PSC") announced on March 12th that the public night hearing in Docket No. 2019-281-S, planned for March 12th at 6 p.m., would be postponed until March 19th in order to put in place a "virtual public hearing" system. In the wake of COVID-19, the 2019 novel coronavirus that has affected the United States, the Center for Disease Control recommends that the elderly and immunocompromised avoid public gatherings and that those experiencing symptoms of the virus stay home; with this information in mind and out of an abundance of caution, the PSC has elected to postpone the planned night hearing until the 19th.

On the 19th, the Commission will hold the rescheduled online public night hearing at 6 p.m. Beginning at 8:15 a.m. on Friday, March 13th and ending at 3:45 p.m. on Thursday, March 19th, consumers must call 803.896.2639 and leave their name, physical address, and telephone number to be pre-registered to testify. The Commission is finalizing details for witnesses to call in to testify and for non-witnesses to listen via audio only; more information on this process will be released through our website (www.psc.sc.gov) and social media profiles (Facebook and Twitter). The meeting will also be livestreamed through the Commission's partnership with SCETV at this link.
