Annual Report of Financial Impact of Videoconferencing Activities
Period Covered: January-December 2019

Date Prepared: January 31, 2020

During calendar year 2019, the Public Service Commission of South Carolina conducted six hearings using videoconferencing as a means of the applicant's participation in the proceedings. Because the applicants resided out of state, the Hearing Examiner assigned to the cases granted the applicants' requests to testify via videoconferencing. In all cases, the hearings lasted less than thirty minutes and videoconferencing allowed the applicants full participation in the hearing process. The applicants would have incurred significant travel expenditures to attend the proceedings in person if videoconferencing had not been used.
