## Public Service Commission Elects New Chair and Vice Chair

Columbia, South Carolina-At their Special Commission Business Meeting of June $6^{\text {th }}$, 2024, the Public Service Commission elected a new Chair and Vice Chair to serve through June of 2026.

Commissioner Carolee Williams nominated Commissioner Justin Williams to serve as Vice Chair; Commissioner Justin Williams was elected as Vice Chair unanimously. A Commissioner since 2018 and former Chairman of the PSC (2020-2022), Commissioner Justin Williams represents the Sixth District.

Commissioner Headen Thomas nominated Commissioner Delton Powers to serve as Chair; Commissioner Powers was elected as Chair unanimously. A Commissioner since 2020 and the current Vice Chairman (2022present), Commissioner Powers represents the Seventh District.

The terms of the new Chair and Vice Chair will begin on July $1^{\text {st }}, 2024$.
