## MEDIA RELEASE: Public Service Commission Publishes Notice of Filing in Docket No. 2025-11-E

The Public Service Commission of South Carolina (PSC) has published a Notice of Filing in <u>Docket No. 2025-11-E</u>, which will be mailed to ratepayers of Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. ("DESC"). This Notice of Filing pertains to DESC's upcoming filing of a Petition in 2025 which will seek authorization to update its "Rider to Retail Rates- Demand Side Management Component" ("DSM Rider") to recover the Company's costs and net lost revenues associated with its DSM programs along with the Commission-approved shared savings incentive for investing in such programs.

Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. has informed the PSC that it intends to file a Petition on January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025 for authorization to update its "Rider to Retail Rates- Demand Side Management Component" ("DSM Rider") to recover the Company's costs and net lost revenues associated with its DSM programs along with the Commission-approved shared savings incentive for investing in such programs. DESC may also find it necessary to request that the Commission modify, expand, amend, terminate, or add any measure or program to its suite of DSM programs. In this case, the Commission will review and determine whether an increase or decrease should be granted for the company's DSM Rider. The actual impact upon customers' bills will be included in DESC's petition to be filed on January 31, 2025, which will be posted in <a href="Docket No. 2025-11-E">Docket No. 2025-11-E</a>.

Important deadlines for customers and potential intervenors to know:

- January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025—DESC will file the Petition with the PSC, including the actual impact of the request upon customers' bills.
- February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025—All Petitions to Intervene must be emailed or mailed to the Public Service Commission per the details contained in the Notice of Filing.
- April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025—All comments from intervenors must be filed with the Public Service Commission.
- May 2025—If approved, any increase or decrease in electric rates will become effective for bills rendered on and after the first billing cycle of May 2025.
