## **South Carolina Public Service Commission Schedules Allowable Ex Parte Communication Briefing for May 4<sup>th</sup> Related to the Grid Resilience Grant Program**

*Columbia, South Carolina*—The Public Service Commission of South Carolina has scheduled an allowable ex parte communication briefing for 10 a.m. on Thursday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023 per [Directive Order No. 2023-206](#). The topic of this allowable ex parte briefing will be the Grid Resilience Grant Program under the [Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act Section 40101\(d\)](#) and the materials will be presented by the South Carolina Public Service Authority (Santee Cooper). Those interested in watching this allowable ex parte communication briefing can attend in person at the Commission's office at 101 Executive Center Drive, Columbia, SC 29210. Registration is required for all in-person attendees so that the record can be certified as required by law and registration will be available upon your arrival at the Commission's office.

An allowable ex parte communication briefing is a form of communication between the PSC and a person or organization involved in a PSC docket or nondocketed item that is conducted in accordance with [SC Code Section 58-3-260\(c\)\(6\)](#). Allowable ex parte communication briefings allow the PSC to receive information from persons involved in matters that come before or are likely to come before the Commission without violating the ethical standards to which the PSC adheres.
