South Carolina Public Service Commission Schedules Two Allowable Ex Parte Communication Briefings for March 10th, 2026

Columbia, South Carolina—The Public Service Commission of South Carolina has scheduled two allowable ex parte communication briefings on Tuesday, March 10th, 2026, at the request of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), and Dominion Energy South Carolina, Inc. (DESC). The first allowable ex parte communication briefing (for DEC and DEP) will begin at 10 a.m. with the second (for DESC) to begin at 11 a.m. or at the conclusion of the 10 a.m. briefing, whichever is earlier. The topics covered during these allowable ex parte communication briefings will be voluntary renewable energy programs, community solar programs, standards for interconnection and parallel operation of generating facilities, and solar choice tariffs. This matter is filed with the Commission as Non-Docketed Item 2025-63-E and all materials filed in this matter are available [at this link](#). Those interested in watching this briefing can attend in person at the Commission's office at 101 Executive Center Drive, Suite 100, Columbia, SC 29210. Registration is required for all in-person attendees so that the record can be certified as required by law; registration will be available upon arrival at the Commission's office.

An allowable ex parte communication briefing is a form of communication between the PSC and a person or organization involved in a PSC docket or nondocketed item that is conducted in accordance with [SC Code Ann. Section 58-3-260\(D\)\(6\)\(a\)](#). Allowable ex parte communication briefings allow the PSC to receive information from persons involved in matters that come before or are likely to come before the Commission without violating the ethical standards to which the PSC adheres.
