South Carolina Public Service Commission Schedules Hearing in TOCE SC Solar 1, LLC Docket (Docket No. 2025-253-E)

Columbia, South Carolina—The Public Service Commission of South Carolina has scheduled a hearing in Docket No. 2025-253-E, which involves TOCE SC Solar 1, LLC's application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction and operation of a 170-megawatt (MW) solar facility in Sumter County.

In their application, the Company seeks a CECPCN for the White Palmetto Project Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility, a 170-megawatt facility that is projected to impact 1,700 acres of land in Sumter County, approximately 12 miles northwest of the City of Sumter near Borden and Black River Roads. The Company is requesting that the Public Service Commission preempt Sumter County's special exception zoning requirement and any other local laws that affect the development, construction, and operation of the White Palmetto Project.

The public hearing in this matter is scheduled for Monday, December 1st, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. with only attorneys present for procedural issues and no witnesses and will reconvene on Wednesday, December 10, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. to receive evidence and hear from witnesses at the Public Service Commission's Hearing Room at 101 Executive Center Drive, Columbia, South Carolina 29210.
